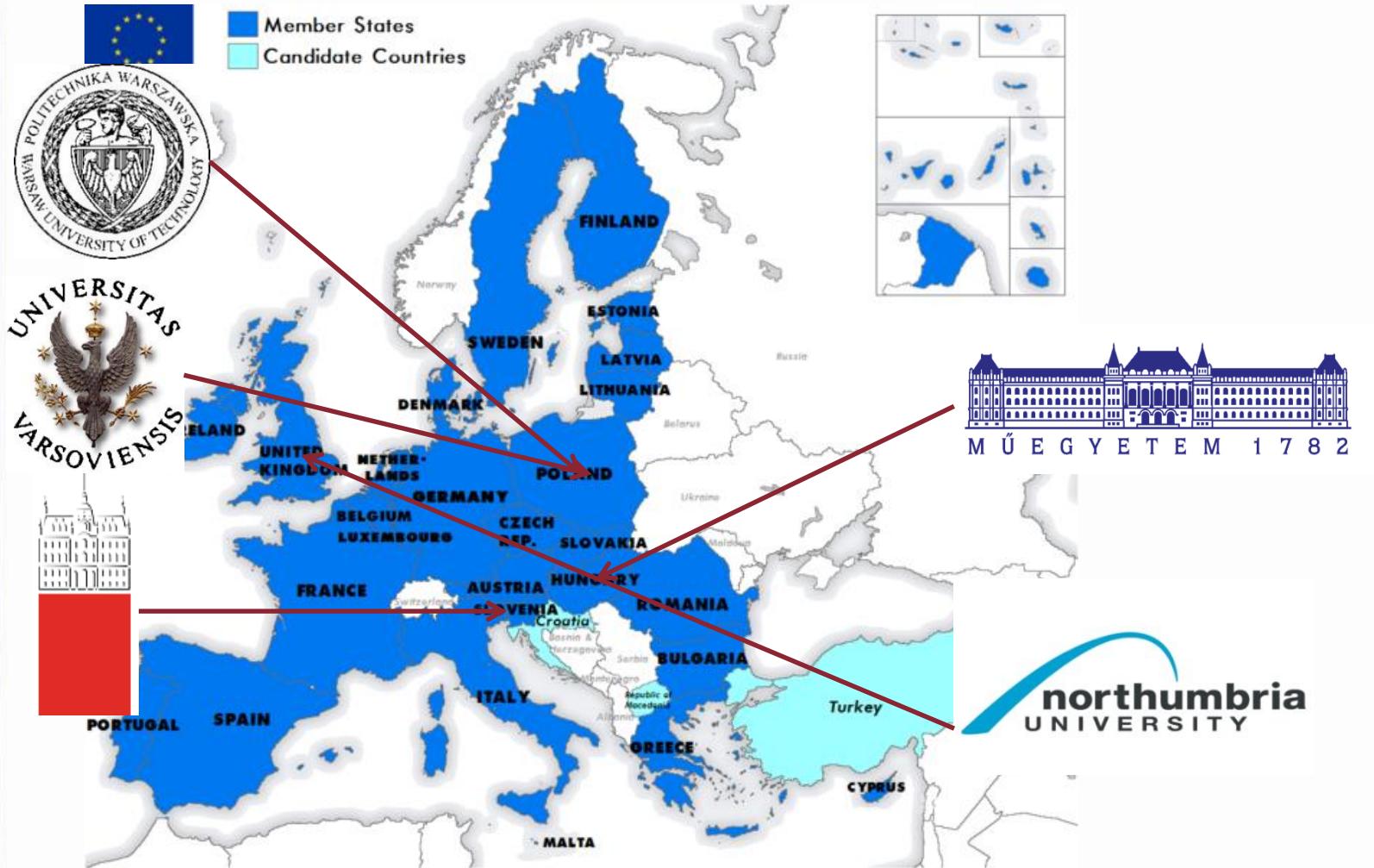


Objectives

4. Visit two EU institutions



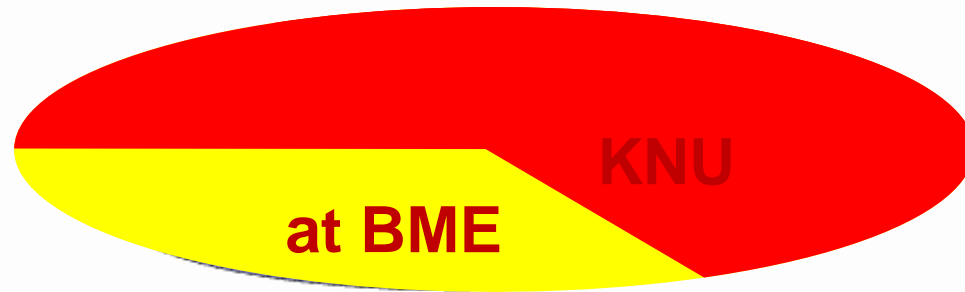

Specific case (with bilateral agreement)



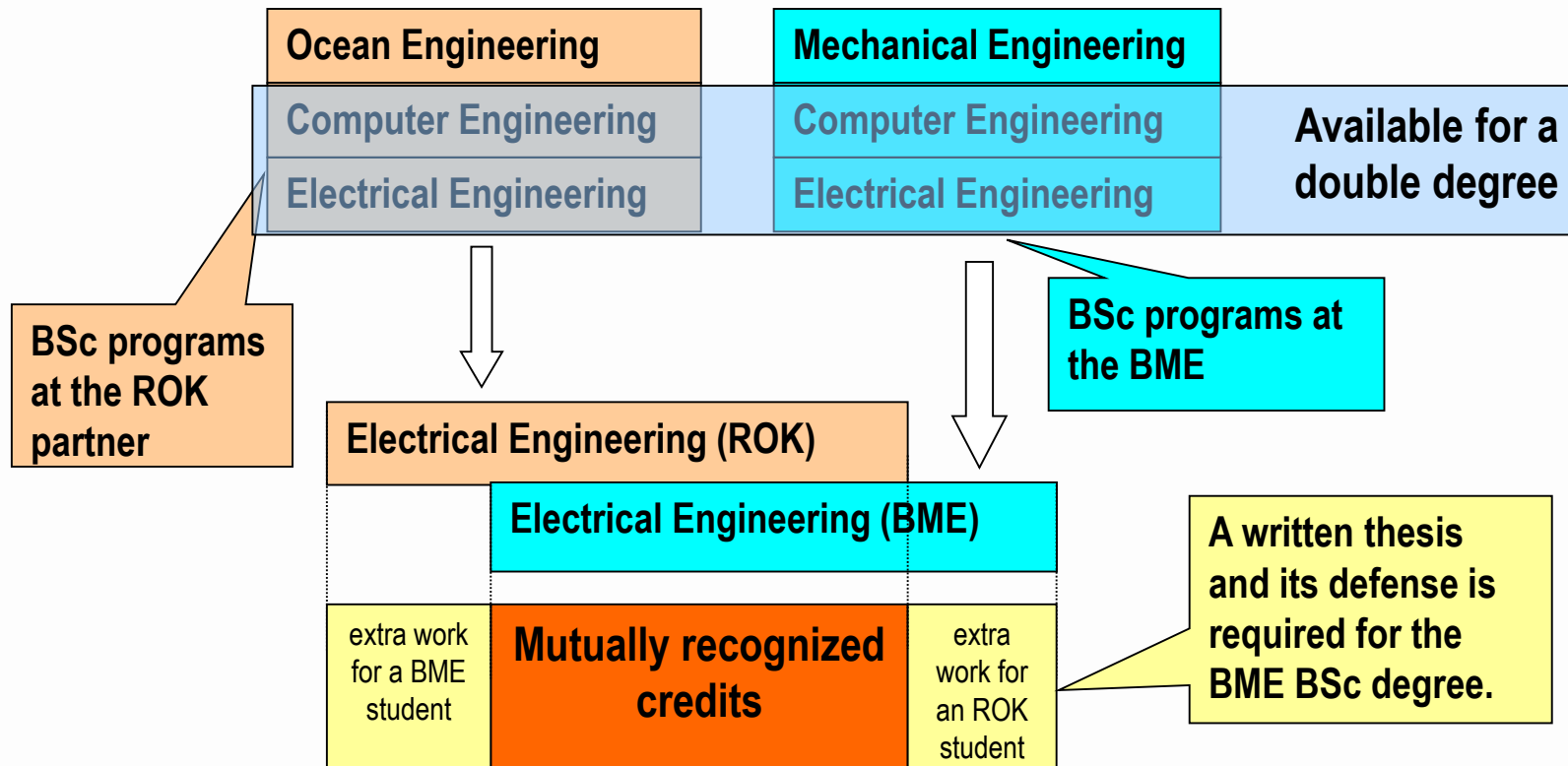
at least 25% of the credits (52) must be obtained at the BME

2 semesters long mobility period



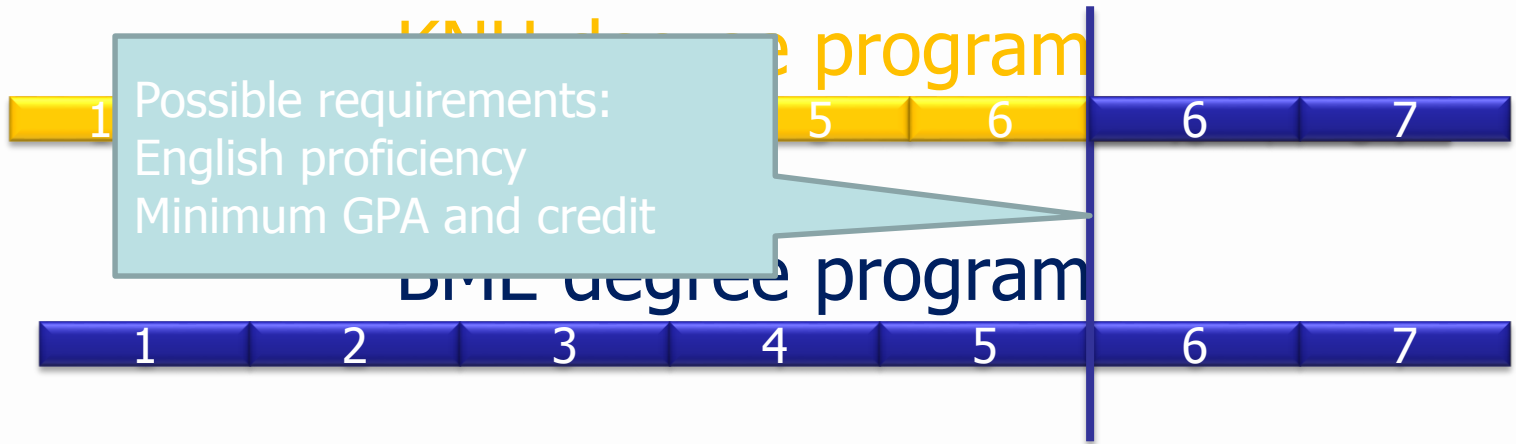
Model

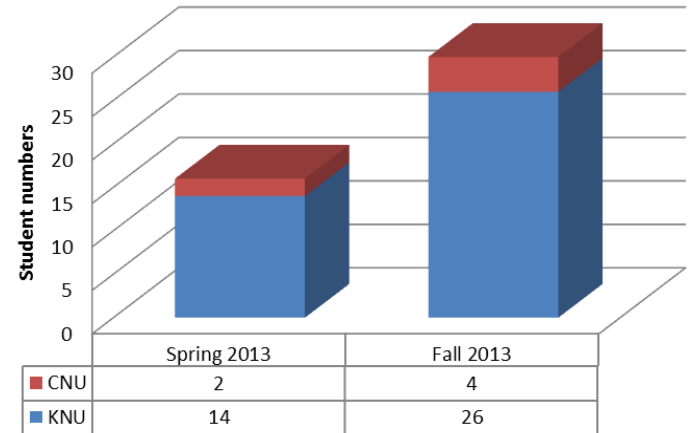
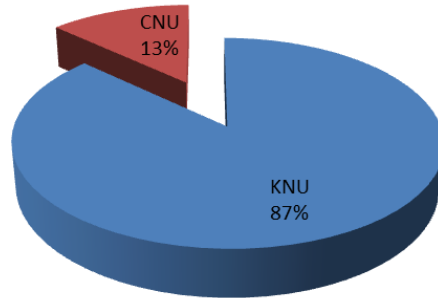
1. Student numbers so far: 65 students.

2. Projected total number: 180 students



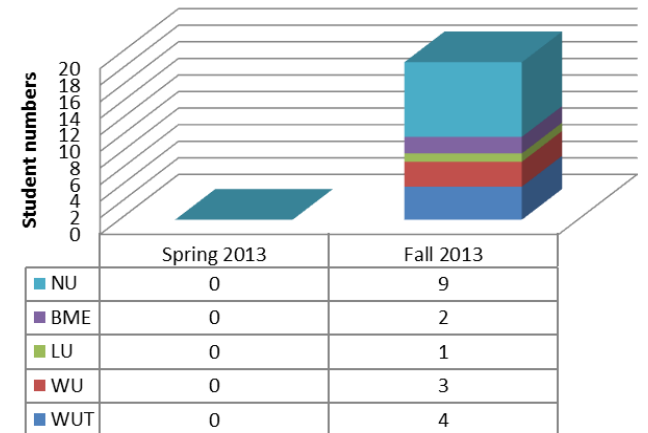
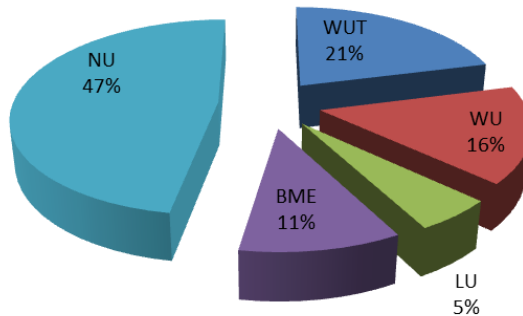

Korean students



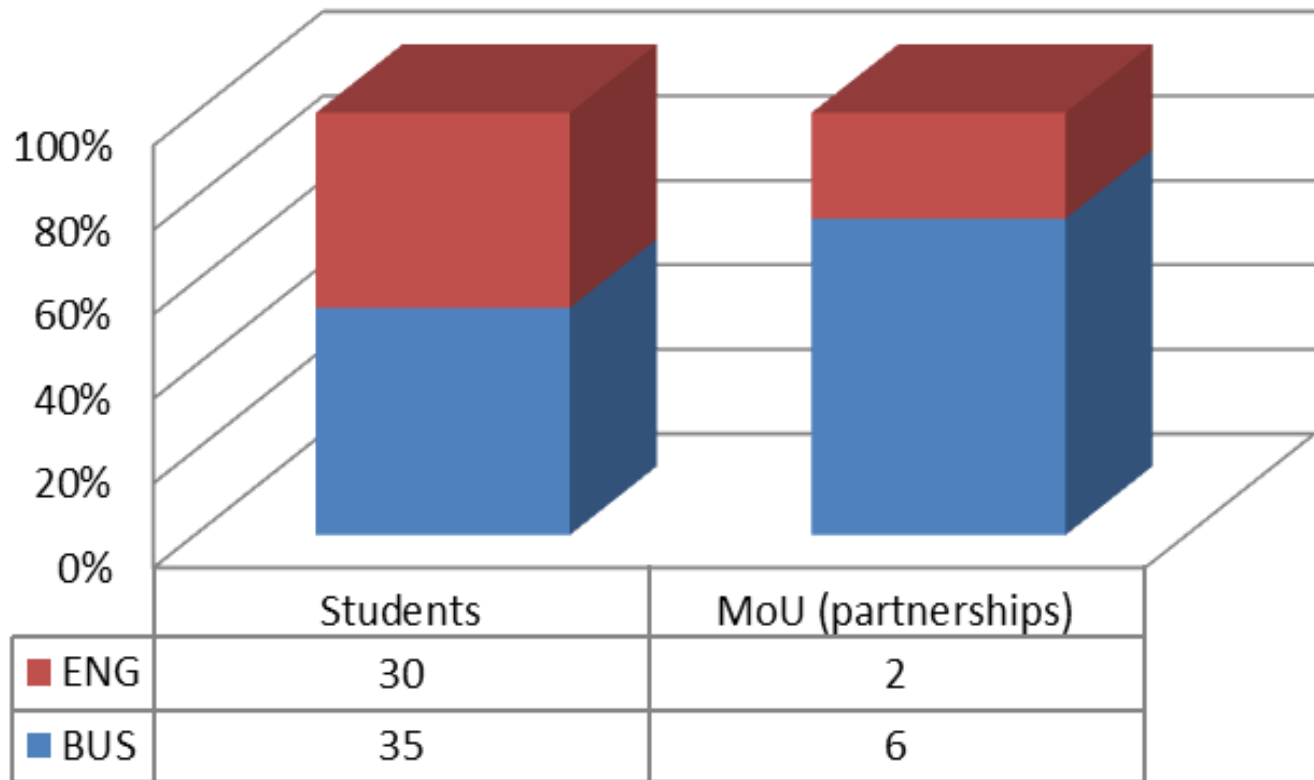

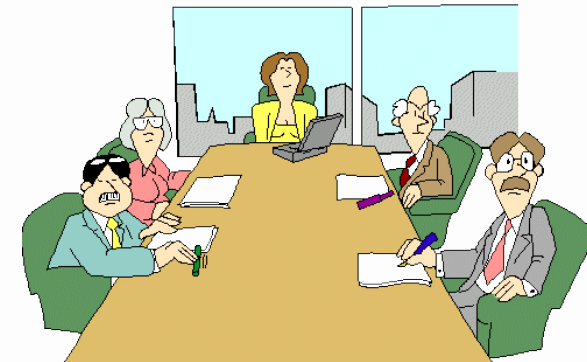
