(funded by EU and Korea Gov.)

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


Objectives

- 4. Visit two EU institutions





Specific case (with bilateral agreement)




at least 25% of the credits (52) must be obtained at the BME

2 semesters long mobility period




Model

- Degree thesis and electives, some humanities classes














Summary


- 1. Student numbers so far: 65 students.

- 2. Projected total number: 180 students







Student numbers












ENG vs BUS








Incoming KNU students - experiences

- Business as usual.
- Predefined study plans are working, only one modification was needed and granted



 NEW: thesis projects completed after returning to Korea will happen in 2015, this requires a video-conf. defense session.









Incoming KNU students

Same lessons learned:

- Awareness about public security issues must be created
- Awareness about high workload must be raised (compared to "normal" exchanges)
- Regular follow-up meetings with students are necessary

All KNU students are now hosted in dormitory. Mixed HU-ROK rooms should be created (?)



Issues

- Large KNU student population with less contacts to outside.
 - All KNU students are now hosted in dormitory. Mixed HU-ROK rooms should be created? (We have one example, it happens well.)
 - Better integration to Erasmus Student
 Network



Outgoing BME students

- Business as usual
- BME continues to offer an additional cofunding of 3000 Euro as contribution to the living costs
- A timing issue: students finishing their stay during summer will need to write their MSc entrance exam while in Daegu.
